Photocopy the sight words on the following pages, cut them apart, then display in a pocket chart in alphabetical order. As you practice finding each word on the word wall, the children will enjoy writing the words on whiteboards. For assessment of word recognition, call out a word and have the children locate it on the word wall and then write it on paper for you to check later. I usually timed this assessment to coincide with a weekly spelling assessment.
